We have just launched a new programme called NUMBOTS. This programme is for our year 1 and 2s and focuses on addition and subtraction. Numbots is run by TT Rock Stars, which our children use from year 3 -6. Similar to TT Rock Stars, your children will practise, in an online game format, counting, subitising and begin to build a rapid recall of their number bonds. These are all foundational skills to build confident Mathematicians. The children have been introduced to the programme at school. They have logged in, stuck their logins in their reading diaries and have had a play already! You should have received a parent letter and some help sheets attached with more information (there are spares in the office). If you scan the QR code, Miss Penfold will talk you through the programme in more detail through a 10-minute YouTube video.

#### Focus on Year 1

We have had a lovely few weeks in Year One, getting to know the children. Our new environment and classroom set up has meant that the children are given freedom to explore and learn, (we call it Discover and Do time) working on their independent and collaborative skills, as well as receiving targeted adult support in small groups. This approach is called Continuous Provision, and though it's new to Bure Park, it has been gaining popularity across the UK and the continent, with a huge body of research suggesting that this is the most effective way for young children to learn. We build on and extend the great curriculum opportunities they have had in the Foundation Stage and 'level up' the learning tasks to meet the Key Stage One curriculum goals. Children have the opportunity to take their learning outdoors and to build on learning experiences via construction, investigation, workshop and other STEM opportunities (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths). Moving forwards we will be setting challenging projects for the children, including the acquisition and care for Guinea Pigs and the redevelopment of the wild area in the grounds to a Forest School space where we can further enhance the children's learning in nature.
