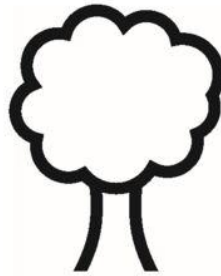

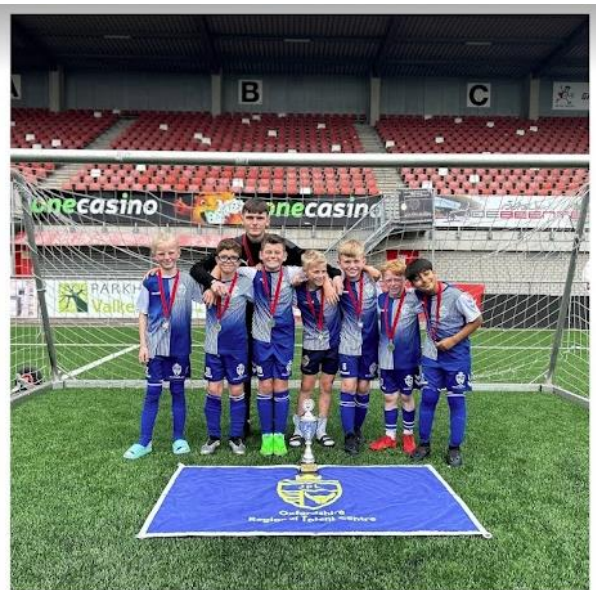


## International Football Tournament
